On completion, a certificate of construction compliance is provided to the client (as appropriate)

Provide a detailed budget/estimate

Compile all documentation and submit to relevant authority in order to obtain a building permit (as appropriate)

Carry out the construction of the project on time and within budget

Critical works are inspected by qualified consultants during the construction process

A pre-completion inspection is offered to the client prior to handover
